## **MSQC/MOQC Cross-Collaborative Project**

Project Time Period: 1/1/2022-12/31/2022

**Summary:** This project is a partnership between MSQC and the Michigan Oncology Quality Collaborative (MOQC). It focuses on hysterectomies performed for malignant indications and associated quality measures such as progression-free survival, overall survival, and opioid prescription reduction opportunities for those patients.

**Project Implementation Requirements:** The data collection for this project is based on hysterectomies performed by gynecologic oncology surgeons. Project implementation requirements are as follows:

- Sites must fully abstract all 2022 Sampled hysterectomy cases as usual.
- Sites will check all "Not Sampled" hysterectomy cases in their sampling frame to determine if the case was performed by a participating MOQC gynecologic oncology surgeon. If so, the site will flag cases meeting these requirements as "Oversampled" in the MSQC Workstation.
- Sites can opt to perform case abstraction of the oversampled hysterectomy cases, including 30day clinical follow-up. Attempting to obtain the PRO survey follow-up is required for the oversampled cases.
- Sites opting not to abstract their oversampled hysterectomy cases agree to allow the MOQC Coordinating Center's abstractor to access their site's EMR and to abstract these cases into the MSQC Workstation on their behalf.

**Bonus Points Allotment:** Up to five (5) additional PI Scorecard bonus points are available to sites that <u>actively participate</u> in this project. Bonus points will be awarded as follows:

- Five (5) bonus points will be awarded to sites that fully participate by over-sampling and abstracting all eligible 2022 gynecologic oncology hysterectomy cases into the MSQC Workstation.
- Two (2) bonus points will be awarded to sites that partially participate by identifying and oversampling all eligible 2022 gynecologic oncology hysterectomy cases but have the MOQC Coordinating Center's abstractor perform case review of their over-sampled hysterectomy cases into the MSQC Workstation on their behalf.
- A maximum of five (5) bonus points will be awarded if requirements are met.
- Earned bonus points will be added to PI Scorecard total, with final scorecard points total not to exceed 100 points overall.

**Project Eligibility:** Sites must meet the following requirements to be eligible for participation in this project:

- The gynecologic oncology surgeons at your site must already participate in the MOQC collaborative (https://www.moqc.org).
- MSQC and MOQC must have confirmed a site's eligibility to participate.
- Sites must designate their 2022 optional case declaration for hysterectomy cases on the annual Optional Case and QI Project Declaration form.
